FIELD TRIPS

Birding field trips are scheduled each month. Full-day and half-day outings cover local birding areas. Occasionally, trips to the coast, national refuges, or for specific species are conducted.

We invite beginners of all ages to our introductory walks on the first Saturday of each month, year round. Walks meet at 9am at the Venture Properties parking lot near the Turtle Bay Monolith.

- We conduct learning walks for beginning birders and newcomers, free to the public.
- We publish and distribute a free checklist: *Birds of Shasta County, California*.
- We publish a chapter newsletter, the *Chirp-N-Chatter*, that strives to keep our membership informed on all activities and interests.
